3. Millenia e- Billing System to combat cyber crime & made internet trust network.
4. Action 1, 2 & 3 is Indonesian Showcase of PPP or Multisector Partnership (MSP) for WSIS Tunis 2005 collaboration APWKomitel (NGO) with government (Ministry of Communication and Information). (Document Geneva Action Plan para. C8.d)
5. Provide platform for communication, advocacy (government regulation) and collaboration between government (public) and APWKomitel's member. MOU with Open University on virtual campus for rural students in remote islands.
